## HOW TO APPLY

As soon as you have been accepted to Einstein, or in advance, you may begin the scholarship application process by filing a new FAFSA at KWWSV VWXGHQWDLG JRY K DSSO\ IRU DLG IDIVD

To be eligible for the Scheiber Scholarship, the student must include parental income and asset information on the 202 -2 FAFSA. The student must also include the Yeshiva University ¶s SchoolCode: 002903 in the school section of the FAFSA in addition to the Title IV School Code of Einstein (allows for up to 10 schools).

Once the materials have been submitted, evaluated, and received by Yeshiva University, send a cover letter addressed to Dean Karen Bacon describing your interest in entering the helping profession of medicine and requesting scholarship consideration. Please include your name, address, and YU ID in the heading.
