The SCW Education Major o ers two program options which are designed to lead to NYS initial certi cation pending completion of education major requirements and NYS requirements for Certi cation:

- Early Childhood (EC) majors apply for Initial certication in Early Childhood Education (Birth-Grade 2)
- Childhood Education (C) majors apply for Initial certi cation in Childhood Education (Grades 1-6)

Students should apply to the educator preparation program by the end of their sophomore year. The application is available on the Education Department website under the Resources tab. Late entrants to the major are required to meet with the Dr. Hirsch to plan their schedules.
