9 | Where are the science labs?

The science labs are in



front lobby of each building, and ask for a shuttle to be called. Security will notify you when the shuttle has arrived.

The intercampus shuttle goes between the Beren Campus, starting at Brookdale Residence Hall (BRH), and the Wilf Campus, ending at 186th Street and Amsterdam Avenue. To sign up for an intercampus shuttle, go to yushuttles.com, where you will be prompted for your username and password.

14 | What is myyu (MY YU)?

yu.edu/myyu is the site you use to access your student records, schedule of classes, academic standing etc. You will use your YU ID number and 6-digit password to enter the site. There will be instructions on how to create your password on the MYYU page. Once you are logged in you can look up classes, register for classes, check your academic standing, check your financial standing and check your "week at a glance" (a computer-generated version of your schedule of classes).

15 | Where are the Computer Labs located?

Computer labs are located in Stanton Hall (245 Lexington Avenue) on the 3rd floor and in the 215 Lexington Avenue building on the 2nd, 3rd, and 8th floors. There are more computers in the libraries on both the Beren and Wilf Campus.

16 | How do I log onto the computers in the computer labs?

In order to use the computers on campus, you must login with your YUAD.

Computer labs are located in Stanton Hall (245 Lexington Avenue) on the 3rd floor and in the 215 Lexington Avenue building on the 2nd, 3rd, and 8th floors. There are more computers in the libraries on both the Beren and Wilf Campus.

17 | Can I photocopy on campus?

There is access to photocopying in the **Hedi Steinberg North Wing Library**. Use your computer username and password to log onto the copier.
